CPLallows students enrollein participating program areas to apply for credit for prior learning to satisfy curriculum requirements for the designated credential. Requests for prior learning credit may include, but are not limited to:

Credit by waiver

- Verifiable jobexperience
- Industry certification
- Non-credit coursework
- Military TranscriptAssessment

Credit by examination

- Nationallyrecognizedexams
 - o Advanced Placement (AP) (Fees for student appayly)
 - o CollegeLevel Examination Program (CLEP) (Fees for studentppby)
 - o Other exams may be considered with approval from the divisitian
- Programspecific challengexams

Southeast Community College's QBlicy is designed to reduce the number of courses a student takes, as well as time and money a student spends in order to obtain their credential from the College. Students may incur fees related to the QBtions they pursue. These fees will need to be reconciled before any transcripeligible credit may be awarded.
