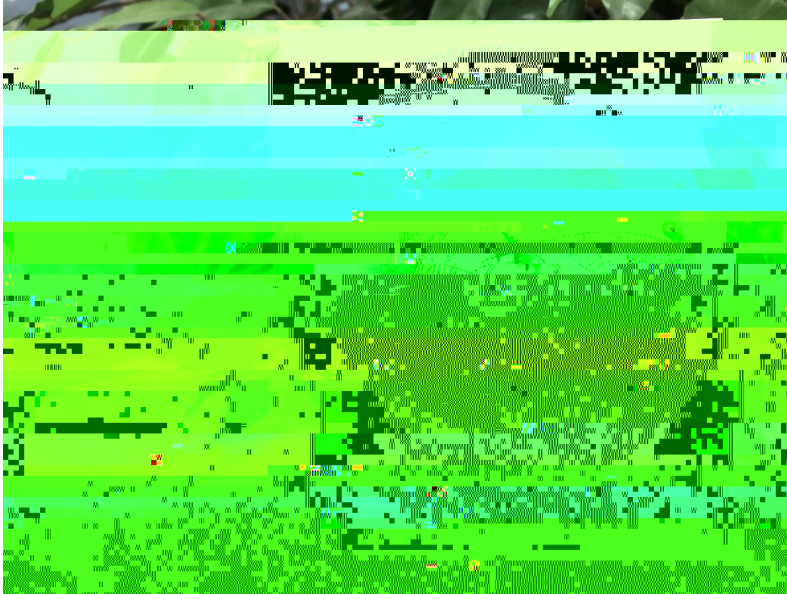

How have you used data or plan to use data for assessment, planning or budgeting at SCC?



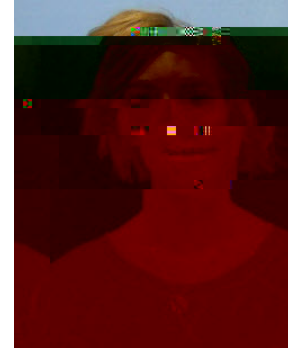

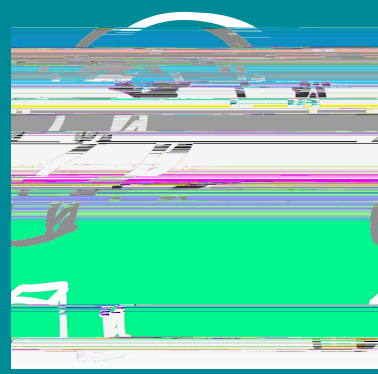
